#### "WHO HAS BEWITCHED YOU?"

Galatians 3:1-5

Let me begin tonight by giving a "disclaimer...."

It is GOOD to understand and celebrate your Jewish roots....for Christianity is Jewish!

It is <u>GOOD</u> to learn the **Jewish culture**... the **history** of God's Covenant people... and their **beliefs**...

It is <u>GOOD</u> to be part of a **Messianic Fellowship** like this one..... where we see the "Olive Tree" from Romans 11 <u>manifested</u>......... Jewish people <u>and</u> Gentile people worshiping the God of <u>Abraham</u>, <u>Isaac</u> and <u>Jacob</u> in a Jewish way... just like the <u>early</u> <u>church</u>.... Jew and Gentile together!

It is <u>GOOD</u> to become **educated** in the <u>richness</u> of the **Jewish perspective** of God's Word.....

It is GOOD to understand the "Feasts of Israel" and "Israel in Prophecy"

It is <u>GOOD</u> to see **God's Holiness** in the teaching of the <u>Torah</u>.

All of this IS GOOD in order to become <u>proficient</u> and <u>comfortable</u> in understanding your <u>faith</u> and sharing your <u>faith</u> with your Jewish friends!!

But... the <u>purpose</u> of this teaching tonight is to <u>address</u> something that is **not** <u>GOOD</u>!

This message will deal with a **very** <u>serious problem</u> that is **prevalent** among many believers today.... <u>both</u> Jewish and Gentile.

Its an **issue** that the Rabbi Paul had to deal with.... **and** in <u>many ways</u> **still exists** today. It has taken a <u>slightly</u> **different** "twist"......but the problem is still there:

#### Should the believer in Messiah be TORAH OBSERVANT?

#### Should the believer in Messiah keep the Law?

There are <u>Jewish believers</u> in the Messiah who feel that they must come back to the "Law"...... and in doing so will become **more** Jewish and **more pleasing** to God.

These Jewish believers are being deceived!

The Jewish believers who try to follow the "Law".... or the part of the "Law" that they're able to keep.... feel that in doing so, it will give them a closer relationship and a closer walk with God.

They feel that if they **study** and **try** to <u>adhere</u> to the <u>teachings</u> **Torah**..... God will **honor** their Jewishness and <u>they it will have</u> **more** <u>credibility</u> in His eyes.

There are <u>also</u> many **Gentile** believers in Messiah who feel **inferior** to Jewish believers.

They <u>feel</u> that they are "second-class-citizens".......

They feel as though they take a "back-seat" to Jewish people....

So... in <u>order</u> to compensate for their **insecurities**... they try to <u>become</u> in **some form** or another..... Jewish!

It's been my <u>experience</u> that <u>the</u> **Gentile** believer who <u>studies</u> and tries to keep **Torah** is also being **deceived!** 

To those <u>Jewish</u> and <u>Gentile</u> believers who have <u>turned back</u> to the **Law** and have become... <u>TORAH OBSERVANT</u>... ... <u>I ask the same question that the Rabbi asked:</u>

#### WHO HAS BEWITCHED YOU?

This was the same question that the Rabbi Paul had for the Galatian churches.

## WHO HAS BEWITCHED YOU? WHO HAS PUT YOU UNDER THEIR SPELL?

#### Turn with please to Galatians 3:1-5 READ PASSAGE:

- \* When Paul called the Galatians "fools..."....he was not violating Jesus' words in the Sermon on the Mount....
  - ....<u>two</u> **different** words are used... in **Galatians 3:1** it means "spiritually dull"... while the word "fool" that Jesus used.... carries the <u>idea</u> of a "godless person."

The letter by Paul to the churches in Galatia was written to correct a serious error.

But certain <u>false teachers</u> had come to **deny** this Gospel of GRACE, or **minimized** its importance.

There are <u>false teachers</u> today who <u>teach</u> that we must <u>come back</u> to the TORAH... study it...... and live by its <u>standards</u>.

The <u>false teachers</u> of today are **teaching** their <u>flocks</u> that we must **become**:

#### **TORAH OBSERVANT!**

They teach their flocks that the word TORAH does NOT mean LAW but means teachings.

Teachings of what? Teachings of the "LAW."

The word TORAH is translated 5 times <u>LAW</u>... 2 times its translated <u>to learn</u>, and only 1 time is it translated <u>teaching</u>.

The <u>false teachers</u> that **Paul** was <u>addressing</u> **insisted** that while <u>we</u> are **saved** by GRACE... <u>we</u> are **kept** by our OWN WORKS.

As a <u>result</u> these Galatians had **lost their assurance** and <u>had</u> gone back to the <u>bondage</u> of the LAW....

This is the very same thing that these false teachers are teaching today!

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Paul's tone was direct and to the point as he protested to the Galatians who were adding "WORKS" to FAITH.....they were keeping the Mosiac LAW ..in addition to their FAITH,

.....as the grounds of acceptance before God.

The Judaizers of Paul's day urged the Galatian believers to OBEY the LAW in order to

receive a <u>more complete salvation</u>.... and a <u>greater sanctification</u>..... .... not unlike the Judaizers of today.

To this the Rabbi asks: "WHO HAS BEWITCHED YOU?"

<u>Paul</u> had **vividly** and **graphically** proclaimed the "crucified" Messiah to the Galatians..... **yet** their <u>eyes</u> had been **diverted** from the **Cross** to the **LAW**.

....The were without excuse!!

In order to <u>demonstrate</u> convincingly that <u>faith</u> ALONE is God's <u>method</u> of dealing with man....

....the Rabbi Paul asked four questions beginning in verse:2:

The first question he asks: "How did you receive the Holy Spirit?"

Paul wasn't questioning their salvation....

.....but **challenged** them to <u>consider</u> **that when** they were saved, did they <u>receive</u> the Holy Spirit by FAITH or on the **basis** of WORKS.

It was of course by FAITH..... they were <u>SAVED</u> when they heard Paul preach the gospel.

Turn to Galatians 4:6: READ VERSE:

When they <u>heard</u> the "good news" and <u>received</u> our Messiah Jesus by **FAITH**... they received the *Ruach Kodesh*..... the Holy Spirit.... and **not** by the WORKS of the LAW!

And its ironic too.... the churches in Galatia did not possess the Mosaic LAW...

the LAW was **given** to God's Covenant People..... the Jewish people.... and **not** the Gentiles!

Paul's **second** question is given to us in verse:3:

"How will you be perfected or sanctified?"

<u>Paul</u> asks <u>if</u> they're so "foolish" to <u>think</u> they could begin the Christian life by FAITH and .....then <u>move on</u> to spiritual maturity by WORKS.

Because this is exactly what <u>Judaizers</u> taught and still teach!!

<u>Judaizers</u> promote the idea that <u>Justification</u> and <u>Sanctification</u> were and are the <u>same</u>!

In their teaching..... they make **no provision** under the LAW for the Holy Sprit to do a **work** of Sanctification.

The Galatians were <u>taught</u> that **keeping the LAW** would help them in their spiritual lives.... but it could not and would not!

The <u>next</u> question that Paul asks in our text is found in <u>verse:4</u>:

"Did you suffer so many things in vain?"

This question <u>looked back</u> on the persecution <u>new believers</u> had experienced in the region of Galatia.

At the <u>end</u> of Paul and **Barnabas's** <u>first</u> missionary journey.... they **warned** the <u>new</u> Galatian believers of the **persecution** they would **suffer** for their <u>beliefs</u>.

#### Turn to Acts 14:21-22: READ PASSAGE:

And persecution soon followed.

<u>Paul</u> reminded them that <u>if</u> they turned from GRACE to LAW they would they would be saying that GRACE was in error....

.... and they would have suffered for nothing!

Paul's **fourth** question is asked in verse:5:

"On what basis did God perform miracles among you?"

The miracles that were performed among the Galatians by divine power is recorded for us in the Book of Acts.

Turn with me to: Acts 14:3; 8-11: READ PASSAGE:

<u>Paul's</u> question makes it clear, that God's <u>supernatural works</u> were not the works of the LAW.....

......<u>but</u> from the hearing that leads to faith.

Once again.... the Galatians did not know the LAW...... and Paul's message was Justification by faith.

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The LAW is a CURSE.....

In <u>Deuteronomy 27:26</u> we hear this:

READ VERSE

"Cursed is he who does not confirm the words of this law by doing them, And all the people will say Amen."

We see **Paul** quoting this <u>verse</u> from <u>Deuteronomy 27:26</u> in his letter to the "foolish" Galatians.

Please turn with me to: Galatians 3:10 READ VERSE

These words are unmistakenably the words of the Holy Spirit!

There are 613 statutes and ordinances of God that comprise the Mosaic LAW.

And the Rabbi Paul <u>asserts</u>..... that any man..... at any time..... or in any measure ...... who has ever <u>broken</u> even one of the LAWS is under the curse and the penalty of the LAW ....and is forever lost.

So I ask you. "Are you putting yourself under the LAW?"

For if you have **not kept** the **entire** LAW <u>without</u> a single interruption.... you are than under the **curse** of the LAW and <u>must</u> **suffer the penalty** of <u>eternal death</u> and <u>separation</u> from our **Creator**.

The BIBLE **emphatically teaches** that **no man** who has ever lived... other than Jesus... has been able to keep the LAW perfectly.

Consider this.... If you've ever had one single UNclean thought.......
....if you ever uttered one hasty word..... if you've ever told one little "white" lie.......

.... if you've ever had one moment in life where you failed to love God with all your might and heart and strength..... you are guilty of breaking God's LAW.

Even Solomon says, "The thought of foolishness is sin!"

I submit to you, that everyone of us here tonight is GUILTY of breaking God's LAW!

That's exactly why God tells us in Romans 3:23: "All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."

#### Turn to Psalm 14:2-3: READ PASSAGE:

In Psalm 14:2-3, David tells us this:

"The Lord has looked down from heaven upon the sons of men, to see if there are any who understand, who seek after God.

They have all turned aside; together they have become corrupt; there is no one who does good, not even one."

Again I submit to you that God's LAW condemns each and every one of us!

We are guilty... and the LAW which is **Holy**... and therefore **it cannot lie**.... MUST condemn the sinner with **eternal death**.

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But its here that God enters in with His wonderful message of GRACE.

The LAW cannot save... justify.... or sanctify the sinner.

The LAW cannot change the heart.....

The LAW cannot <u>teach us</u> to <u>live better</u>.... it cannot help us out of our <u>predicament</u> in any way <u>whatsoever</u>.

All the LAW can do is demand punishment and justice.

All the LAW can do is <u>pronounce our sentence</u>.... <u>reveal our filthiness</u> and unworthiness..... AND curse our disobedience with <u>eternal death</u>.

That is the only ministry of the LAW.

The LAW was never intended to save!

And...God knew that when He gave the LAW it could never save anyone!

God knew that His LAW would never make anyone better!

God knew that the very people that <u>He gave the LAW to</u> could **not in themselves** keep it!

So, I ask those of you WHO are "TORAH OBSERVANT"... those of you WHO have gone back to the Torah.... the LAW:

"Who has Bewitched you?"

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Maybe your <u>asking</u>, "is the LAW completely powerless?" "Can't it do anything at all?"

NO the LAW is not powerless.

Its power is to reveal how sinful we are.... and its power is to curse us for our sins.

So YES... the LAW is extremely powerful!

But again, the LAW is utterly powerless to save a sinner or to sanctify a believer!

THAT never was the purpose of the LAW.

IF the LAW could <u>save the sinner</u> or <u>sanctify the believer</u>... than the **Messiah** would never have had to die at all!

The Rabbi Paul addresses this in: Romans 8:3

READ VERSE:

Please notice the beginning of this verse: "For what the LAW could not do..."

There are some things that the LAW cannot do ....

The LAW could not justify....

The LAW could not save or pardon or redeem......

The LAW could not forgive or change the heart of man...

This is **not** a <u>fault</u> or <u>weakness</u> of the LAW...... **but**, <u>on the contrary</u>...

...... <u>its</u> because of the <u>STRENGTH</u> of the LAW that <u>we see</u> the **weakness** of the human flesh and heart.

We were told in Romans 8:3.... "For what the LAW could not do, weak as it was through the flesh....."

It was <u>the weakness of the flesh</u> that <u>prevented</u> the LAW from <u>doing anything</u> but <u>curse</u> the sinner.

The sinner's <u>flesh</u> is corrupt......by the way.... when we speak of the flesh... we're speaking of man's corrupt nature... <u>PAUSE</u>

.....even the believer's flesh is filthy and corrupt...... ....and because the LAW is Holy... and perfect... and just... it can only condemn those who have not kept the LAW. \*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\* BUT NOW... we come to a glorious revelation!! The Word... comes to dwell with man! The incarnation of Jesus the Messiah! What the LAW could NOT do...... the Messiah Jesus DID do! He came to deliver us from the curse of the LAW. That's right! He came to deliver us from the LAW itself! The LAW was a slave-driver.... an executioner..... seeking to kill us because of our sins. But than, Jesus comes on the scene and does two things: He lives a perfect... Holy... sinless life for thirty-three and a-half years...... .....He lives in full... complete... and perfect obedience to the LAW in every detail. He provided the <u>positive</u> righteousness of the LAW. Than He did the second thing...... He paid the death penalty of the LAW for us. He than proved that He paid the penalty of sin for us by RISING from the grave after three days.

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The penalty of the LAW was paid at <u>Calvary</u> and... in addition....

....<u>He has provided a perfect righteousness</u> by His sinless life..... which is imputed to those that believe on Him.

The Messiah Jesus offers both of these by GRACE....His free gift... to any sinner who will turn from LAW to GRACE......

......from his or her own works.... to the finished work of Messiah Jesus...

Salvation and Justification before God is offered to any sinner who will admit that he or she cannot keep the LAW and receives Jesus as their Lord and Savior.

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To those who receive our Lord by faith... our Messiah does two things:

<u>First</u>... He imputes.. or credits.... to the <u>forgiven</u> sinner.... His perfect.... sinless righteousness.... which He proved and provided by His own sinless life.

By the death of our Messiah.... the believer has HAD paid for him the penalty of the LAW which he owed.

By the life of the Lord Jesus... the <u>believer</u> is **now clothed** with the **perfect**.... **sinless** righteousness of JESUS Himself.....

Because of the life of the Lord Jesus.... the <u>believer</u> can stand BEFORE God the Father as though he's never committed a single sin....

Because of the life of the Lord Jesus.... the <u>believer</u> can stand BEFORE God the Father as though he's never once <u>broken</u> the Holy LAW of God!

THIS ... my friends is Justification..... a truth that so very few understand!

Believers are not pardoned sinners...... for the LAW knows no pardon....

The LAW knows no mercy! It knows ONLY punishment!

And that is why Paul says in Romans 8:3-4:

"For what the Law could not do, weak as it was through the flesh,
God did: sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and
as an offering for sin, He condemned sin in the flesh.
In order that the requirement of the Law might be fulfilled in us,
who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit."

Please NOTICE this statement: "In order that the requirement of the Law might be fulfilled in us,"

It does NOT say that "the requirement of the LAW might be fulfilled BY us ...."
.....but rather "IN us.".....and Jesus our Messiah does that!

The "righteousness" or the "requirement" of the LAW that we couldn't achieve...
...and the "righteousness" or the "requirement" of the LAW that could NOT be
fulfilled BY us .....

....<u>is</u> provided by the ONE who bore our sins at Calvary... the Messiah Jesus!

Which brings us back to Galatians 3:10:

"For as many as are of the works of the Law are under a curse; for it is written, 'CURSED IS EVERY ONE WHO DOES NOT ABIDE BY ALL THINGS WRITTEN IN THE BOOK OF THE

### LAW, TO PERFORM THEM."

Each of us stands guilty before God!
BUT what the LAW could NOT do Jesus DID!
We read this is in <b>Galatians 3:13</b> :
"Messiah redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become
a curse for us - for it is written, 'CURSED IS EVERY ONE WHO
HANGS ON A TREE"-
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And those of us here tonight who are trusting in Jesus ONLY for our salvation
we are now delivered we have been discharged from the LAW!
For Romans 7:6 tells us:
"But now we have been released from the LAW, having died to
that by which we were bound, so that we serve in newness of
the Spirit and not in the oldness of the letter."
Please understand this The person who receives Jesus as their Messiah Lord, and
Savior is THROUGH with the LAW FOREVER!
If you are trusting in Jesus as your Messiah for your salvation
you are delivered from the LAW
you are <u>dead</u> to the LAW

.....and you are free from the LAW.

#### Turn with me please to: Romans 8:2:

#### READ VERSE:

The LAW condemns.... BUT the <u>believer</u> in the Messiah Jesus <u>has</u> a **new relationship** to the LAW.... and <u>therefore</u> he <u>CANNOT</u> be condemned!

We have been made free from the LAW of sin and death.

We now have life in the Spirit.....

The LAW **no longer** has ANY **Jurisdiction** <u>over us</u>..... we are **dead** to the LAW.... and as <u>we just read</u>.... we are now **FREE** from the LAW.

The Judaizers and the Legalists of today try to obey God in their own strength....

.... but, they fail to measure up to the righteousness that God demands.

<u>BUT</u>... the Spirit-led believer.... as he <u>yield</u>s to the Lord.... <u>experiences</u> the sanctifying work of the Holy Spirit in his life.

We're told in **Phillipians 2:13**:

"...for it is God who is at work in you, both to will and to work for His good pleasure."

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I have two very definite appeals tonight.

<u>First</u>... to those of you who are putting yourselves under the LAW by becoming

# ..... I beseech you to come back to the TRUE TORAH.... the Messiah Jesus .......come back to His teachings.

Rather than putting yourselves under the yoke of the LAW with its 613 commands....
...the commands that can never be kept....

... rather than <u>putting yourselves</u> under the CURSE of the LAW that could never <u>save</u> anyone...

...rather than <u>putting yourselves</u> under the curse of the LAW that cannot make anyone a <u>better person</u>.....

.... rather than putting yourselves under the LAW that has already been fulfilled....

#### Submit yourself to our Lord's TEACHINGS of the NEW Covenant!

... come back to the Covenant of Grace that gives life.... life everlasting...

... come back to the Covenant of Grace that sanctifies and satisfies the soul.

<u>IF its</u> commands that you <u>need</u>... than submit yourself to the "Brit Ha dasha".... the New Covenant...

Its been **estimated** that <u>there are well over</u> **2,000 commands** <u>by our God</u> in the New Covenant... the Covenant of Grace... <u>keep THOSE commands</u>!

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The **SECOND** appeal I have tonight, are to those who are trying to attain to Heaven and eternal life without the Messiah Jesus. There are so many today who believe that if they live a good life.... ....or if they join a synagogue or church... .... or if they go through all the rituals of religion or spiritualism.... ...or if they behave themselves... ....or make an honest effort to keep the LAW..... THEN GOD WILL SAVE THEM. The BIBLE knows **nothing** of this kind of salvation! God says: "There is none that does good, no not one." As God's Word tells us.... "all have gone astray." Its for this very reason the Messiah Jesus had to die on the Cross at Calvary.... .....Jesus died on the Cross to provide that which we were absolutely unable to attain. As I stated earlier..... the LAW was never intended to save.... ..... BUT rather to show us our need for salvation. According to the Rabbi Paul.... the LAW is a "schoolmaster." The LAW was given to teach us our own inability.... .....the LAW was given to make us READY to receive the "free gift" of God by His own wonderful GRACE.

The LAW is like a mirror..... it shows us how soiled our face is....

.... but it has **NO** power to cleanse.....

After we view our filthy condition... we can turn from that "mirror"... the LAW....
......to Him who shed His precious blood and redeemed us and washed us from our sins.

When you receive the <u>Jesus</u> as your <u>Messiah</u>..... you have God''s assurance that the LAW has been fulfilled in HIM.

You have the assurance that His righteousness is imputed to you.....

You have the assurance that He has paid the PENALTY of your sin in full.... and you can sing along with the hymnist:

Free from the LAW, Oh, happy condition!

Jesus has died and there is remission.

Cursed by the LAW, and ruined by the fall,

Messiah has redeemed us, once for all.

Once for all, oh, doubter believe it,

Once for all, oh, sinner, receive it.

Come to the Cross, your burden will fall,

Messiah has redeemed us, once for all.
